BACKGROUND

Statistics

- 80% of the victims are females
- majority of perpetrators are males
- age of victims as low as 4 years
- persons are reluctant to report

Some reasons:

1. fear of negative consequences of reporting

2. embarrassment of stepping forward

3. it was not their business

4. the process would take too long

5. did not know who to report to
