



## **Biographical Note**

## Antonio José Ángelo Motti Federal University of Mato Grosso do Sul

Professor Ángelo Motti is Brazilian. He is a psychologist and technical specialist in educational matters. His fields of specialization are social psychology and social communication.

He is on the faculty of the Federal University of Mato Grosso do Sul, where he coordinates a number of outreach projects in the field of human rights, and predominantly, the rights of children. His coordination of the *Escolla de Consejos* Programme is particularly significant.

Among his most relevant activities in relation to the issues to be addressed at the 21<sup>st</sup> Congress are:

- The design and execution of the specialized social care programme for child victims of sexual violence in Brazil, as part of the social assistance public policy – the Centinela Programme, now known as CREAS.
- The design, coordination and execution of the Programme for Integrated and Framework Actions to Fight the Abuse and Sexual Exploitation of Children and Smuggling for those purposes in Brazilian territory PAIR.
- The general coordination of the Regional Network Project to Fight Trafficking in and Smuggling of Children with the purpose of Sexual Exploitation in border regions – PAIR Mercosur, within the sphere of action of the Niño@sur Working Group. This project included integrated regional action with Argentina, Brazil, Paraguay and Uruguay and constituted a significant experience in relation to synchronization between institutions and States.
