Managers

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Objective

Provide tools for understanding and applying international standards on the human rights of children and adolescents and promote the implementation of the Convention on the Rights of the Child and the application of the American Convention on Human Rights in matters relating to children and adolescents.

Participants Profile

Professionals and practitioners linked to systems for the promotion and comprehensive protection of the rights of children and adolescents in States of the region: public sector agencies (health, education, child protection, security, justice, local governments, among others) and civil society organizations.

Modality

Virtual, self-managed, through the Moodle platform.

Duration

Four modules that participants must complete within a maximum period of eight weeks.

Evaluation and approval criteria
